


DESIRE DESIGNING

CREATIVE

The competition asks for creative design for a Vertical city. The competition doesn't ask for a heap of sheets but a concise idea of vertical city with respect to current era. We don't want a replica of the conventional mixed-use building. Instead we ask you to design a building which incorporates a group of residence where they can access all the necessary basic needs under one roof.

We ask you to choose a site near to your locality not more than 1500sqm. Participants are free to site their projects anywhere in the world. But this is not to undervalue the importance of site – participants should carefully consider their site (which must be a "real" site, in an existing urban location) as the site context should inherently have significant influence over the project's design.

We suggest you to consider the climatic and geographic factors. [The building bye laws or local building rules can be neglected]. The concept and design must be original. We ask you to look into the functional as well as aesthetic part of the design.
